Most trails are wide and open, with some bridge crossings, a short time on a road, and one water crossing. We ask that you not attempt the jumps along the trail as they have not been groomed or checked for safety for this event.

Parking will be very limited and we encourage you to trailer-carpool when possible! Enter at main gate and PLEASE follow parking attendant volunteers to assist with maximizing our capacity for the day.

PLEASE OBSERVE COURTEOUS TRAIL ETIQUETTE. When passing, please walk when approaching and departing a slower group, and give adequate distance before resuming a faster pace. Communication is KEY! Many people bring young or green horses that can get rattled by the commotion and excitement, and we wish all riders to have pleasant rides, no matter the pace at which they ride.
